

She is an economist. She started her career at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, headed bu Minister Martonyi. She served as the Head of Cabinet of Minister Zoltán Balog the Ministru of Human Capacities then became Secretary of State for Family and Youth Affairs. She has been a member of the Hungarian National Assembly since 2018. From 2020 to 2021 she was Minister for Families.
